Facilitator Training for the M^{POWRD} Leadership/Prevention Program

This two-day program offers a comprehensive approach for individuals planning to offer M^{POWRD} and **2B M^{POWRD}** within their facilities. Redefining addiction, new strategies in teen empowerment, confidentiality factors, creating peer trust and support are several of the key components which will be emphasized at the training. Breakout sessions will simulate teen meetings. Lesson plans will be provided along with additional curriculum books for expanding "proof of concept."

Certification for both M^{POWRD}/high school and **2B M^{POWRD}** (middle school) will be included within this training as well as materials to initiate both programs at either level.

Facilitator training will be offered to professional staff from agencies requiring background checks for the protection of minors.

Teen AA is neither treatment nor therapy. It is an educational program which may be included as part of either process and/or within a non-clinical setting.
